### Challenge

When the UK Government identified that their end-product reporting systems were out-dated and required a modernised approach, Austin Elliot was commissioned to design, integrate, and implement a new system, embedding a centralised, common approach for all stakeholder agencies.

### Solution

Austin Elliot designed and integrated a new, up-to-date end-product management system to meet the needs of the three aligned government agencies, delivering through the following tasks:

### Results
